# STAR Naming Opportunities

**Indoor Arena Building** - This large structure dominates our facility and allows STAR to double up classes, as well as keep our riders protected during inclement weather. *A gift of \$400,000 may be used to name the Indoor Arena Building.*

**Indoor Arena Riding Area** - Classes, workshops and many other activities such as horse training and events will take place in the arena. *A gift of \$250,000 was made possible by Robbie Nutt.*

**Grooming Area** - Instrumental in rider lessons; this area is not only where the rider experiences the discipline, but also the satisfaction that comes with caring for another living being. *A gift of \$40,000 was made possible by the Regal Foundation.*

**Compost Station**—This structure converts a by-product (manure) into a sought after commodity (compost) thus allowing STAR the ability to reuse, recycle and offer this product to the community. *A gift of \$20,000 may be used to name the Compost Station.*

**Tack Room** - Essential to every equine center, this climate controlled room is the hub for volunteers to store all the equipment used with horses. *A gift of \$30,000 was made possible by the Harris Family—Stephen, April, Sommerville and Bo.*

**Observation Porch** - What a wonderful respite for parents and caretakers to observe the small pleasures of their child in the arena from the comfort of rocking chairs on a shaded porch. *A gift of \$30,000 was made possible by Home Federal Bank.*

**Apartment** - The apartment provides STAR with round-the-clock care for our facility and equine friends. *A gift of \$25,000 may be used to name the Apartment.*

**Rider Waiting Area** - This is the main entrance to the barn where over 20 weekly riders eagerly wait for their turn to get them to start class, need to relax, observe the grooming class and converse with each other. *A gift of \$10,000 was made possible by the Farragut Rotary Club.*

**10 acre Pasture** - What a wonderful area for our horses to graze and stretch their legs. Necessary for physical and mental health, the pastures allow the horses to be...horses! *A gift of \$20,000 may be used to name a 10 acre pasture (3 of 4 available).*

**Stall Shavings Storage** - Necessary for sanitation and comfort, shavings are used daily in stalls to keep our horses healthy & happy. *A gift of \$5,000 may be used to name the Stall Shavings Storage area.*

**Great Room** - A prime opportunity to sponsor STAR's indoor gathering place. The Great Room is used to conduct Volunteer & Staff trainings, serves as a classroom during inclement weather and is a meeting place for various community organizations that come to learn about STAR. *A gift of \$50,000 may be used to name the Great Room.*

**Observation Room** - Watch riders hard at work, as well as clinics, horse shows and STAR's stallions in a climate controlled and seated room offers views of the entire arena. *A gift of \$50,000 was made possible by the Lenoir City Civitan Club.*
